The service will conclude with the sounding of the Shofar.

Selichot is observed on the Saturday night prior to the beginning of Rosh ha-Shana.

It serves to usher in the true start of the High Holy Days and is spent engaging in activities that remind us of the priority of repentance, learning and doing good deeds.
